Training:

Being Registered with the State of Texas I'm required to complete at least 30 hours of training annually and the training must be in the follow categories:

- Child Growth and development
- Guidance and discipline
- Age-appropriate curriculum
- Teacher-child interaction
- Care of children with special needs
- Child health (Nutrition and Physical Activity)
- Safety regarding Fire Drills and Hazardous Weather
- Risk management
- Identification and care of ill children
- Cultural diversity of children and families
- Professional development (effective communication with families, time and stress management)
- Preventing the spread of communicable diseases
- Topics relevant to the particular ages of children in care (caregivers working with infants and toddlers should receive training on biting and toilet training)
- Planning developmentally appropriate learning activities
- Observation and assessment of all activities
- Attachment and responsive care giving, set standards and how they apply to the caregiver based on the Minimum Standards Program by DFPS.
